

Touchscreen Setting Procedure.

Click on “PLAYBACK [Tablet PC]” on REVEAL.
The settings window will open.

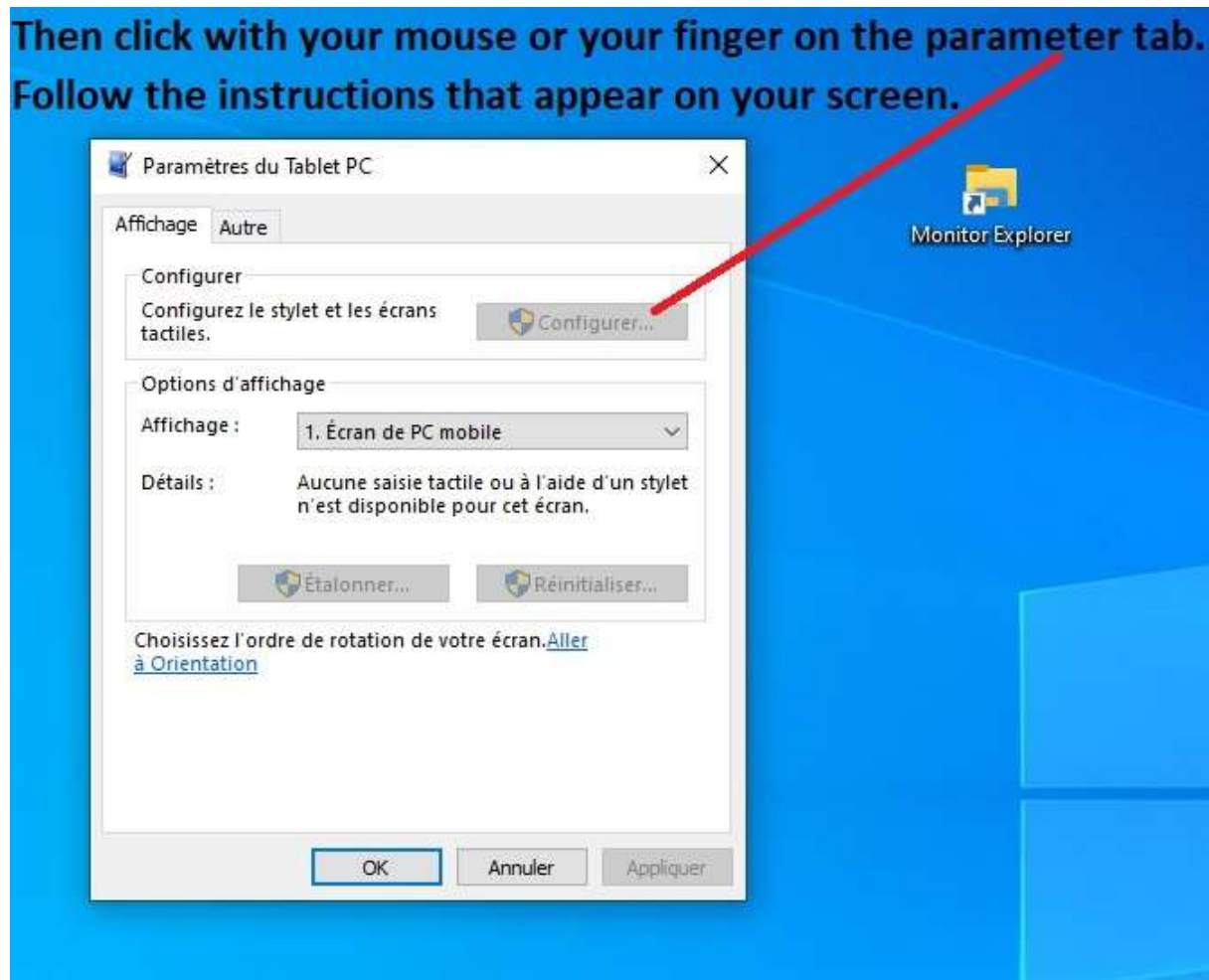
In some cases, if you have set your touchscreen as your Main Monitor, this window setting can be launched under your touch workspace. In this case type Break Pause key (Pause Attn in French) for REVEAL or Scroll Lock key (Arrêt défil in French) for REVEAL Alt on your PC keyboard to Toggle show/hide your touch workspace.
